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HISTORY OF BALLET ETUDES

It all began 26 years ago....Well, actually... It really began more than 26 years ago.

Before Ballet Etudes began, the highest level dancers at Huntington Academy of Dance were called "Apprentices." They performed Nutcracker excerpts at the studio, schools, and community centers. Gary Joyce performed Drosselmeyer in a purple sweatsuit! The Apprentice dancers performed every single role in the second act. No one realized that they were learning much more than Ballet. As they spent their weekends in the studio, completing homework between scenes, they became a family – the family that would become Ballet Etudes.

Combining Marnell Himes-Ushijima's vision and the support of the founders, Gary and Muriel Joyce took the lead as Artistic Directors and Ballet Etudes was born. The company offered students the opportunity to grow in artistry and theatrical presentation with larger-scale productions. Funds were raised through our generous supporters, commissioning our very own Parlor drop and Christmas tree that magically grows and lights up! We rehearsed and danced with new purpose. We touched audiences over generations as hundreds of families made Ballet Etudes' Nutcracker their holiday tradition.

Like the Stahlbaum's Christmas tree, Ballet Etudes grew and evolved. Several amazing Artistic Directors have added to the original vision of Miss Marnell, Gary and Muriel Joyce, such as Jewell Tweeton-Donnelly in 2000 and Sofia Carreras in 2002.

In 2003, Miss Judith Hawkesworth became Artistic Director during a time of transition for the company. She brought the company to new heights, and Ballet Etudes experienced incredible growth under her leadership as she began casting young children in the spring productions. The next year, Marie de la Palme joined the artistic staff and created the storyline that we use today.

In 2006, Kimberly McEachern returned to Ballet Etudes where she had performed in her youth. Under Kimberly's artistic direction, along with Julie Ertl and Tami Simons, Ballet Etudes grew by leaps and bounds. Miss Kimberly and Miss Julie created several new ballets for the company including Bug's Life, Mulan, and Miss Kimberly's favorite, Candyland. Ballet Etudes continues create exciting new ballets for audiences to this day.

Ballet Etudes sponsored our first Community Outreach Program in 2012 to bring the art of dance to underserved communities. Today, we are teaching free dance classes at various Title I schools.

Ballet Etudes dancers become teachers, and our teachers become Directors – this is a testament to the success of our program. Miss Sasha Robertson, having danced in our very first Nutcracker, is now our Artistic Director contributing her visions to the Nutcracker. Over the past 10 years, Miss Sasha has exposed our dancers and audiences to other great classical ballets, including Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, and Cinderella, as well as Aladdin, Little Mermaid and Jungle Book.

And it still does not stop there. Ballet Etudes dancers have become doctors, attorneys, business owners, professional dancers and incredible humans. The kids you see on stage, from the littlest lambs to the Sugar Plum Fairy are all a part of our present and our future.

This is who we are, and where we came from.

The Nutcracker In a nutshell...

Act 1

It's Christmas at the Stahlbaum family home. Many guests arrive to celebrate around the beautifully trimmed tree. Clara and her rambunctious brother, Fritz, await the arrival of their Godfather, the mysterious Herr Drosselmeyer and his nephew. When Drosselmeyer arrives, Clara discovers that despite his age, he is quite spunky. Amongst the dancing and revelry, Drosselmeyer entertains the crowd with three life-sized, dancing dolls, bringing a special magic to the party. Herr Drosselmeyer then gives gifts to all of the children, saving a very special gift for Clara: a Nutcracker. She adores her Nutcracker, but Fritz snatches it away and breaks it. Clara is upset, but Herr Drosselmeyer repairs the doll and gives it back to her.

After the final dance, the guests leave and the Stahlbaum family retires for the evening. Later that night, Clara steals downstairs to play with her Nutcracker. Suddenly, she is surrounded by mischievous, life-sized mice. Herr Drosselmeyer enters and rescues Clara. He then casts his magic, causing the Christmas tree and everything around it to grow! Drosselmeyer himself mysteriously becomes a young man again. His nephew is magically transformed into a life-size version of Clara's Nutcracker, who leads giant toy soldiers to battle against the mischievous mice and the evil Rat King.



Just when it seems the Rat King is about to defeat the Nutcracker, Clara throws her slipper at the Rat King, distracting him long enough for the Nutcracker to strike a fatal blow. All of the excitement is too much for Clara, who faints into her Godfather's arms.

After Clara wakes, Drosselmeyer encourages her to dance again and turns the Nutcracker into a handsome Prince, who thanks Clara for saving his life. Led by precious Snow Babies, they travel through the Kingdom of Snow, where they are welcomed by the lovely Snow Queen, her Princesses, and the Snowflake Court.

Act 2

As they leave the Kingdom of Snow, they are greeted by Angels, who lead them into the Land of Sweets to meet the Court of the Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier. Drosselmeyer tells of Clara's bravery in helping the Nutcracker Prince defeat the Rat King. The Court cheers, and the Sugar Plum Fairy calls for a celebration. Clara is delighted as she is entertained by the members of the court, all representing some delicious confection: Chocolate, Coffee, Tea, Peppermint, Marzipan and Gingerbread. The celebration culminates with a beautiful pas de deux (dance of two) with the Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier. The Sugar Plum Fairy and Dewdrop Fairy invite Clara to join in the dancing, and she eagerly accepts.

As the celebration comes to an end, Clara has fallen asleep. The Land of Sweets slowly fades away, as Herr Drosselmeyer returns Clara to her home. As he leaves, his youth fades and he returns to his present age. Clara wakes as he is leaving and thanks him for the most magical Christmas night. She returns to her chair and hugs her Nutcracker. A dream? Reality? You decide... but the Christmas magic will live on.





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The Nutcracker Artistic Team



Sasha Robertson (Artistic Director): Sasha has been a part of the Ballet Etudes' artistic staff for 15 years and has been directing since 2012. She began her ballet training with Marnell Himes-Ushijima as well as Gary and Muriel Joyce at Huntington Academy of Dance at age 5, studying and examining in the Cecchetti method. She continued her training with advanced commercial dance in high school and college but began to focus her attention on teaching. After more than 18 years, Sasha remains on HAD's faculty and has obtained her Associate teacher certification through Cecchetti USA. As an alumna of Ballet Etudes, Sasha has performed in the company's Nutcracker countless times, starting with BE's very first Nutcracker 26 years ago, dancing roles from Mouse to Snow Princess to Spanish lead, just to name a few. She has also danced lead roles in other

Ballet Etudes productions, such as Cinderella, the Little Mermaid, and Snow White and the Magnificent 7. Sasha has directed and/or helped produce many Ballet Etudes productions, including The Nutcracker (2012-2022), Swan Lake (2016), Jungle Book (2017 and 2021), Sleeping Beauty (2017), Aladdin (2018), Don Quixote (2018), Beauty and the Beast (2019), Alice in Wonderland (2012 and 2019) and Hercules (2020). Sasha graduated summa cum laude and Phi Beta Kappa from the University of Southern California with bachelor degrees in theatre and environmental social sciences. While at USC, she performed in several School of Theatre productions and was also fortunate to be selected to choreograph a full dance accompaniment to the Greek tragedy, "Agamemnon." Sasha holds her J.D. from USC Gould School of Law and works as a project development and finance attorney at Troutman Sanders LLP. She is grateful to be able to balance her legal career by sharing her love of dance with the upcoming generation of Ballet Etudes' ballerinas. When she's not working, Sasha enjoys spending time with her husband, two children and two Weimaraners.



Madison Simons (Co-Assistant Director): Madison Simons was born and raised in Huntington Beach, Calif. She grew up dancing at Huntington Academy of Dance under the direction of Marnell Himes-Ushijima. She was a company member with Ballet Etudes Youth Ballet Company for five years, in which she performed roles such as Alice in Alice in Wonderland, Wendy in Peter Pan, and Snow Queen and Sugar Plum in The Nutcracker. Madison is classically trained in the Cecchetti Method of ballet, and has passed her Cecchetti Final Diploma exam. Madison also holds her bachelor's degree in dance science from Cal State Long Beach and is a certified Pilates instructor. She now resides in Colorado and is so grateful to continue working with Ballet Etudes remotely. She is so excited to see the girls dance and wishes all the dancers to "break

a leg" and enjoy every moment on that stage!



Bridgette Burnett (Co-Assistant Director): Born and raised in Huntington Beach, Calif., Bridgette received her early training at Huntington Academy of Dance under the direction of Marnell Himes and was a part of Ballet Etudes for eight years. She continued her training at Southland Ballet Academy. She competed in and won the Orange County Star's of Tomorrow competition at Segerstrom Center for the Arts in 2005 and 2006 and was a semi-finalist in 2005 and 2006 for the Spotlight Music Awards Competition. She went on to spend five years with Festival Ballet Theater, directed by Salwa Rizkalla, where she performed a wide range of soloist and principal roles in productions of Sleeping Beauty, Don Quixote, and Swan Lake and worked with choreographers such as Jodi Gates, David Allen, Molly Lynch, and Edwaard

Liang. Bridgette received the Carolyn Cunningham scholarship at Cal State University Long Beach, where she received her B.A. in dance and performed works by Sophie Monat and Lorin Johnson. In 2009, she joined Monat Dance under the direction of Sophie Monat and performed principal roles at various Galas such as the McCallum Theater's Dance under the Stars Choreography Festival and Celebrate Dance in Los Angeles. She participated in the National Choreographer's Initiative in 2012, directed by Molly Lynch where she performed works by Thang Dao and Darrell Grand Moultrie. She then went on to join Smuin Ballet in San Francisco and performed works by Adam Hougland, Michael Smuin and Amy Seiwart. She took some time off to have her two beautiful babies and is now back teaching and dancing at Huntington Academy of Dance, where she first fell in love with this art form and ultimately found her passion for dance. She is now the Assistant Artistic Director of Ballet Etudes and manages HAD Conservatory where she works with students to help them reach their goal of dancing professionally. She has watched her dancers receive offers from Joffrey Ballet, Ballet Met Milwaukee Ballet and Alberta Ballet. She is also currently a member of Emergent Dance Company where she gets to dive into her own art form and express herself through her own dancing on stage! She is thrilled to be working with the next generation of HAD ballerinas and instilling her knowledge and love of dance into each and every one of them!



Kimberly McEachern (Managing Director): Kimberly is the owner and Artistic Director of Huntington Academy of Dance, Managing Director of Ballet Etudes, and the Director of "DANCE HB!" for Huntington Beach Parks & Recreation. Kimberly, who received her training from Brenda Joyce, Marnell Himes-Ushijima, Gary Joyce and Rebecca Wright of ABT, earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from UCLA in 2000 and holds her Licentiate certification with Cecchetti USA. In 2011, she was awarded the prestigious Enrico Cecchetti Final Diploma. Kimberly has been training dancers for over 25 years, and her students have gone on to professional dance careers, received dance merit scholarships at universities, and won numerous national and international dance competitions. Kimberly enjoys teaching and coaching students and is committed to promoting classical

ballet in Orange County. As a mother of three young boys, she enjoys working with and is honored to mentor the young ladies at the dance studio.



Marnell Himes-Ushijima (Director Emeritus, Huntington Academy of Dance & Founder, Ballet Etudes): Ms. Marnell is a Fellow of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance, Cecchetti Branch, where she holds the Final Diploma. Ms. Marnell has served as Executive Director of Cecchetti USA and USA delegate to Cecchetti International. She began her training with Sheila Darby and continued at the National Ballet School in Toronto, Canada, and has extensive professional performing experience. Ms. Marnell has traveled throughout the United States and internationally teaching master classes and examining for Cecchetti USA. She was honored by the Allied Arts Board of the City of Huntington Beach as Arts Educator of the Year and received the Integrity in Business Award from the Rotary Club of Huntington Beach. Her former students

have danced professionally with companies such as NYC, Miami City, San Jose, Joffery, Ballet Pacifica, and LA Ballet, and in musical theatre, and have become dance teachers, choreographers, and artists. She is also very proud of her students who have gone on to many other professions, such as doctors, teachers, therapists, etc. She is also pleased to see the children of former students at HAD.



Melody Plastow (Rehearsal Assistant): Melody began her training in Sacramento at First Covenant Dance Studio, performing with the company and teaching there for 2 ½ years. She attended CSU Long Beach where she was able to train with Lisa Johnson, Andy Vaca, and Jenny Lee Stevens. She graduated in 2010 with her bachelor's in history, and then moved to Mississippi where she trained with Ballet Magnificat! In Mississippi she had the privilege to be taught by founder of the company Kathy Thibodeaux and Jiri Sebastian Voborsky. Melody graduated from the trainee program in 2012 and moved back to California. Upon moving back, she began teaching for HAD and Ballet Etudes in 2013 and has taught at many studios around the area. During this time, she also went to culinary school and received her diploma in

Baking and Pastry and went on to own a bakery business for three years. Melody has danced with Emergent for 6 years, is a registered yoga teacher and has her Associates Teaching Certification in the Cecchetti ballet method. Melody is also in her final year of her masters and will obtain her M.A. degree in Mental Health Clinical Counseling with a specialization in Dance/Movement Therapy in May 2023!



Rebecca Hamrock (Rehearsal Assistant): Rebecca, a California native, trained with Salwa Rizkalla, Alla Artyushkin, Julia Ellis and the talented staff of Houston Ballet. After achieving top silver in the finals of the Dorothy Chandler Spotlight Awards, David Wilcox asked Rebecca to join L.A. Classical Ballet as a company member. Her professional career continued in 1995 with Kirk Peterson's Hartford Ballet where she danced numerous soloist roles like Myrtha, and Lilac Fairy to name a few. Miss Hamrock was also grateful to perform guest roles like Grande Pas Classique, Black Swan Pas, and Diana and Actaeon with many companies around the world, as well as, doing some TV work on the side with the Jay Leno Tonight Show. During this time, she also started refining her teaching and coaching skills. She taught in Long Beach Ballet Arts

Center's and Southland Ballet Academy's star studded summer programs and ballet mistressed their award winning junior companies. In 2003 and 2004 Rebecca staged full length La Bayadere and Cinderella for China's National Guangzhou Ballet. She has also set, danced, and assisted for several of Robert Sund's (Emmy winner) Ballets at State Street Ballet, Ballet Pacifica and choreographic workshop performances all over San Francisco. Since retiring, she has worked at a variety of schools and companies including Concordia University where she developed their first ballet program. She has coached NY YAGP Grand Prix and Princess Grace winners and even set 2nd Act Swan Lake for the 2008 China Olympic Tour. While working for Garrett Smith, she set and assisted for companies such as New York City Ballet, Cincinnati Ballet, Ballet West Utah, and National Choreographers Initiative among others. Locally, Rebecca has trained super star Lex Ishimoto (SYTYCD winner), Clarice Ordaz, and Angel Gibbs, among others. Many of her students continue to train and/or perform in schools and companies such as Juilliard NY, Tisch, Houston Ballet, Oregon Ballet Theater, ABT, Royal Ballet London, Stuttgart, and many more. Over the past several years, Rebecca choreographed and reimagined a full length Don Q for Long Beach Ballet and helped in the creation of David Wilcox's new elaborate Cinderella. Now, she hopes to continue teaching though out Southern CA, as well as, collaborating with other talented performing arts professionals.



Gunta Liepina-Miller (Rehearsal Assistant): Gunta is a Latvian choreographer, dancer, dance instructor, and Fulbright scholar currently working in Southern California. She got her MFA in Dance at University of California, Irvine, and her BFA in dance in Jazeps Vitols Latvian Academy of Music. In addition, she has studied at CODARTS Rotterdam Dance Academy in the Netherlands, Tsech summer academy in Moscow, Mark Morris, Complexions contemporary ballet, and many more. As a dancer she has performed with ballet company Grande, Indra Reinholde chamber ballet, contemporary dance company Kairos in Los Angeles, and has worked with such choreographers as Lisa Naugle, Jessica Torres, Keith

Derreck – Randolph, Mario Camacho, Anouk van Dijk, Hans van ManenLorand Zachar. She has also worked as a commercial dancer and choreographer for TV shows The X Factor and Your Face Sounds Familiar. Gunta's works have been showcased in many prestigious places including Highways Space in Santa Monica, The Latvian National Opera, Latvian National Dance Group. Gunta's reimagined Nutcracker was nominated for the Latvian Dance Awards and received the audience choice award. Her choreography and dancers advanced to the semi finals in the TV show Dance Revolution in Lithuania. Her choreography has been showcased in the USA, Latvia, Lithuania, Thailand, China, Russia, Italy, Bulgaria, Lithuania, etc. Together with her husband Stefan Miller she has established Young Artist Residency in Kuldiga, Latvia for young emerging singers and dancers.



Erin Conners (Rehearsal Assistant): Erin Conners has been a Ballet Etudes Rehearsal Assistant since 2015. Erin has been dancing at Huntington Academy of Dance since the first grade and performed in many Ballet Etudes' Nutcracker productions.
